

To charge Greg V with misappropriation of NA funds, due to he called and renewed our contract with AT&T on November 11, 2009.

Events that transpired to this motion are:

The chair, Ethan, called for the executive committee to meet in October and discuss possible ways to save money. On the morning of the October Area meeting, the chair, vice chair, and treasurer met and discussed various ways to save money. One of those ways to save money was to remove our advertisement from the Yellow Pages.com. When the treasurer made contact with our account contact, Busnic Ledyard, Paul was told that we had to make a decision by November 16, 2009. At the October Area Meeting, after hearing pros and cons on the subject, the Area Chair, Ethan, made the decision to call it to a vote. This was a vote on to remove our name from the Yellow Pages.com and save \$75 a month, yearly total of \$900, while remaining in the White Pages for free. No cost to the Area. Reference letter copy from account contact.

The Area voted on the motion and was carried by a 2/3 vote. For unknown reasons this motion was not entered into the October minutes. After the Areas conscience, Paul made contact with AT&T, and cancelled the ad in the Yellow pages.com. We were also ensured we would be in the White pages at no cost. We did receive conformation via letter which is attached.

At the November Area meeting, Greg V. appeared at the service committee and was made aware of the Area's conscious, conversations with AT&T, and events that had transpired. The ASC was not informed of any other issues on the matter, other that some debate.

In the December Area meeting, the service body was informed by Greg V. that he made contact with AT&T, and changed the contract, which would incur costs of \$75 per month, a yearly total of \$900. The service body was told that they were back in the Yellow Pages.com. Also after reading the December PI report, this sole decision was confirmed that the contract was changed after the Area's conscious to delete us from yellow pages.com.

The Treasurer spoke with AT&T within the last couple of weeks and was told that the contract was actually renewed on the date of November 11, 2009.

1. As written in our Area Guidelines, number 9, page 10, under misappropriation/misuse of NA funds it states: "The Eleventh Concept of NA Service establishes the sole priority for

the use of NA funds to carry the message to the addict who still suffers. The Twelfth Concept of NA Service gives the AREA a mandate from the NA groups that call for total fiscal accountability. With this in mind, any misappropriation or misuse of funds by any Area trusted servant(s) or NA member(s) cannot and will not be tolerated. The definition of "misappropriation of funds" includes but is not limited to, theft, embezzlement, or use of NA funds for purposes not expressly authorized by an Area Committee, Subcommittee, or Ad hoc. This includes the theft of cash, check, any financial instrument (i.e., refunds, royalties, or rebates from vendors to the NA Fellowship), or asset (i.e., equipment, supplies, or physical inventory)."

Tradition 2 says "We must remember that offices have been placed in trust, that we are trusted servants, and at no time do any govern. Narcotics Anonymous is a God-given program and we can only maintain our group in dignity only with group conscience and God's love." Page 61 5<sup>th</sup> Edition Basic Text.

Many concepts were also broken during this event. Concept 2 states "The final responsibility and authority for NA services rests with the NA groups."

Concept 3 states "The NA groups delegate to the service structure the authority necessary to fulfill the responsibilities assigned to it"

Concept 6 states "Group conscience is the spiritual means by which we invite a loving God to influence our decisions."

Concept 8 states "Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications." This concept states that when our groups ask the service structure to fulfill certain responsibilities on our behalf, we delegate to the structure the authority needed to make decisions related to those responsibilities.

Concept 9 states "All elements of our service structure have the responsibility to carefully consider all view points in their decision making processes." All the information was presented to the ASC body at the October meeting.

Also on page 10 of the area guidelines it addresses Restitution. It states, "A member removed from office for the misappropriation or misuse of AREA funds might be subject to criminal and/or civil legal proceedings. Members removed from office for the misappropriation or misuse of AREA funds may, at the discretion of the AREA, be asked to sign a promissory note and make restitution in full of all misappropriated or misused AREA funds in lieu of filing charges."

Intent: to see if other groups feel the same.

#### **Discussion**

Add to guidelines under Article X: voting; Section 1, Letter J: Voting on all CAR/CAT motions shall be done on a group by group basis with all RCM's bringing the groups' votes to the region where the total number of yes, no and abstention votes are tallied. In the event of a tie, the RD will take a vote of present, but not voting.

**Intent:** So the vote reflects the true conscience of groups in the Region Discussion of motion-

Comment – There are four ways to vote at the WSC; yes, no, abstain, present but not voting. Present but not voting does not count against the total number of votes as an abstention does. This way our Regional Chair doesn't have to break a tie for our Region on WSC matters.

Intent: To replace the NAWS Vision Statement with a vision statement for all NA services.
