Administrative & Subcommittee Reports

Chair – Clay- I have met with the junior and senior executive committee. We apologize for being remiss in our duties. This area voted to remove a group from the meeting schedule. After much research we have found that once a meeting has been taken off the schedule, they are no longer recognized as having voting privileges. So in lees this body suggests otherwise the WOLF group will no longer be recognized or have voting privileges. We will discuss this further in new business.

Vice Chair – Charlie- I attended a meeting with a local CPA along with other members to research this area's options concerning our current and future sales tax situation. Details and recommendations will follow in our area treasurer's report.

I also met with our area chair to go over our current area by-laws and am in the process of updating those procedures to include any changes made in the last 6 months.

Secretary – No report given.

Treasurer -

Hello family,

Our balance as of today 1750.40 leaving us 502.94 below our prudent reserve. So obviously we will not be making a contribution to region this month. This should also cause some concern to the area. I wish I had a better reason for this however the answer is simple; we are spending more money a month (on our regular expenses) than is being contributed. If this continues much longer there will need to be some decisions made ,by the area, on our budget. Over the past few months we have been averaging a monthly donation of 500 dollars. The area spends at least 900 dollars a month just on ordinary expenses such: H&I literature, phone line, and public information necessities. In the past couple months there have been other expenses that don't usually occur (car reports and rent for learning days and workshop). So if the area wants to continue with our budget the way it is. The GSR'S need communicate with their groups that the area needs support.

On a good note the executive committee as well as the alternates met with an accountant about doing our sales the right way. There are several options the area has to choose from to do this. One of them is incorporating the area with the state as non-profit corporation. To do this we would have to fill out a 501C3 application as well as come up with by-laws the government would use to govern how we do business. This would limit the area to two fundraisers a year; this would include ROR. We would also have to give all our financial history up for an audit performed by an accountant. This might cause a problem considering some of our history. I was told the only reason to do this is for liability purposes in case the area was to get sued.

Another option is to set up a non-profit organization account without incorporating with the state. To do this we would again have to give our financial history to an accountant for an audit. There would be a fee of 500 dollars to do this. And again we would be limited to two fundraisers a year. And we would not be tax exempt. Also there would have to be a sales tax increase for every time literature is sold. Meaning the area , the home group ,and the individual buyer would be obligated to pay sales tax. This is one of the correct ways ,however there aren't that many advantages to doing this. Both of these processes would also take a very long time. The applications to do each of these are usually denied the first

couple of times. The reason for this is to make sure all rules and guidelines are coherent with the law.

Another option is have the home groups buy their own literature directly from SHOWME with maximum amount of 4800 dollar annual purchase. This would however do away with a valuable service that the area provides with the groups. If the area chose this route all fundraisers would have to come to a stop. The reason for this is by taking this route the area is deciding to not buy and sale anything. This includes tee shirts, fees to enter a function, and raffle tickets.

Another option is for the area to obtain a sales tax number from the state. The area would charge sales tax for anything sold. Again this does include tee-shirts and raffle tickets. However the individual buyer wouldn't have to pay the sales tax. And each month the area would write a check to the state for the exact sales tax amount. This is option the accountant thought would be the easiest and most fitting. The executive committee agrees with this. The area needs to make note that all the options thus far either forbid or restrict fundraising. There might be something to think about there.

The last and probably least option is for the area to pretend ignorance. The accountant said that its unlikely that the government would investigate an association such as ours. However I don't think doing this is coherent to the principles in our literature. And if we did this and were investigated we would face penalties.

I have hope that with all this knowledge and these options the area can make a confident and ethical decision. I hope that even with my inexperience I conveyed this information clear and simple as it could be.

Also if someone went on the website January the 20th they might have been alarmed that the website subscription ran out. There was a miscommunication between the previous website and myself. In any event, the problem was taken care of that night and we now have a two year subscription. I apologize for this and I appreciate the area's patience.
