For the past several months this area has been operating under it's prudent reserve and is in jeopardy of having to downsize or possibly even eliminate some of the subcommittees which are vital to carrying the message to the still suffering addict.

This motion would allow us to use the proceeds from each year's ROR to fully fund the following year's ROR. We would not have to have the multitude of ROR fundraisers in order to fund the event and would hopefully allow us to put more money into the 7th Tradition basket.
