

## **OPEN FORUM**

## TOPIC #1

Chris W. - Not trying to dwell on the problem but rather to find a solution, there is poor participation in our area. This needs to be a problem that we identify and begin to work on. Various events in the recent past have had poor attendance.

Phil "Being new to this area I've noticed that there is no continuity to the events in this area. An activities chair would play a key role in keeping unity and strong communication of events in the area.

## TOPIC #2

Dixon "My home group (Spiritual Principles) has a concern that the home groups were not able to vote on a bid to have the VRC in Knoxville. We have many vacant positions at the area level but we are wanting to host a huge event that will require a lot of service commitments from members of our area. If we are having an activity that requires more than \$200 we have to vote on it at the home group level yet the home groups never got a chance to vote on whether or not we send a bid for the VRC. This does not seem right.

Chris W. "The group that has the VRC usually has nothing to do with area.

Greg V. "I knew that someone would say, that is just the way we do it. We need to focus on building leadership within our area. My desire is that more of us look at the area as we look at our home groups. What works at the home group level should be applied at the area level.

Phil "I suggest that we set it up in the guidelines that every 4 years we nominate a chair for VRC.

Jim "An RCM is needed. Had we had a RCM a lot of this confusion would have been avoided.

Rex "There is no excuse for why these area positions are not filled.

Chris "Having a VRC would help to get these area positions filled. It would train people how to serve at the area level.

David "As treasurer, I am somewhat confused about the ROR funds. Does the prudent reserve motion affect the upcoming ROR? Will the 2007 ROR leave \$2000 in prudent reserve for the next years ROR?

Clay "Is Bradford going to allow you to abide by NA traditions?

Walker "Yes, they are.

John "The revised version of the by-laws did not reflect changes that were voted on and passed when they went back to the home groups. It does not seem like the revised by laws were accurately updated.


