Next meeting has yet to be confirmed, depending on the December 6<sup>th</sup> event.



## Outreach-

### OUTREACH REPORT November 16, 2008

We met today from 9am- 11:30am. There were seven members present, representing four different home groups. We opened with the serenity prayer, reading the traditions and concepts, and reading the entire eleventh concept. After reading the eleventh concept, we had time to discuss it.

Our next order of business was to read two IPs suggested by the Outreach Resource Information. They were IP number two, The Group and IP number twenty-one, The Loner – Staying Clean in Isolation. We especially liked IP number two, The Group. The subcommittee wanted me to encourage the GSRs to take a look at this IP, as it was the first time many of us had read this IP and we found it to be a tremendous resource.

Finishing these readings marked a milestone for us as a subcommittee: we have read all known available resources that specifically address Outreach work. I am grateful that we have taken the time to read this literature together as a group before setting guidelines or making any group visitations. This work will pay off in the form of effective service to this area, its groups, and members.

Before we began work on a set of guidelines, we discussed what our priorities should be as a subcommittee. Our top two priorities are 1.) Providing service to the groups in our area and 2.) Facilitating workshops and learning days. There was a lot of discussion regarding how, specifically, we are going to provide service to groups. The outcome of this discussion was that our priority will be to initially visit groups in the area in order to let them know that we are here to help and how we can help. Don't worry Better Way of Life and Long Road Home – we have not forgotten about you. We plan to visit the groups that have asked for help first. After the discussion, we began taking a look at two sets of guidelines. Our work is not finished. What we did was read through, section by section, and take notes. There were suggestions regarding additions, deletions, and rewording of several items on the sample guidelines. Most of the changes are in order to focus or "tailor" the guidelines to fit our Greater Smokey Mountain Area.

Our work with these guidelines will continue on December 13<sup>th</sup>, at a location and time to be announced in the next week. If you would like to be a part of this process, please get me either your phone number or e-mail address today. Otherwise, we will be meeting again at this location on December 21<sup>st</sup> at 9am.

One more piece of information: I plan on moving out of this area somewhere around July 1<sup>st</sup> of this coming year. That means I could not knowingly take a year commitment for Outreach chair in December. I have talked about this with several other members, and received just as many suggestions. There was discussion at the subcommittee meeting today as well. I have expressed my willingness to the subcommittee to continue with the responsibilities as chair, but would like to leave that seat open. Essentially, we will get the work done no matter what. It just may be better to have someone volunteer to be the Outreach chair that plans to stay here for at least a year. Remember – there are no emergencies in NA. ILS,
